THE GENOTYPE OF FORCIPATA
(Homoptera-Cicadellidae)

The genus *Forcipata* was described by the authors in 1936 (Ann. Ent. Soc. Amer. 29:70). At that time nine new North American species were described in the genus but inadvertently the genotype was not designated. It was the plan of the authors to designate *loca* as the genotype in view of the fact that it is the most common and widespread species of the genus which occurs in North America. *Forcipata loca* DeL. & Cald. is therefore designated as the genotype.
