## THE GENOTYPE OF FORCIPATA

(Homoptera-Cicadellidae)

The genus Forcipata was described by the authors in 1936 (Ann. Ent. Soc. Amer. 29:70). At that time nine new North American species were described in the genus but inadvertently the genotype was not designated. It was the plan of the authors to designate loca as the genotype in view of the fact that it is the most common and widespread species of the genus which occurs in North America. Forcipata loca DeL. & Cald. is therefore designated as the genotype.
